Post: Lead Youth Worker

Main Purpose

The lead Youth worker will deliver youth work sessions with a focus on creating positive outcomes for young people and tracking young people's journey of change. The role involves one to one focused work with young people helping them to progress towards personal structured goals and towards continued education or getting into employment. The sessional youth worker will be leading innovative youth-based activities at evening sessions and holiday provisions.

1. What is the overall purpose of the role?

To lead on the delivery of youth provision that enable young people in the Hounslow

- 1. Establishing evening and weekend youth provisions
- 2. Design, lead and participate in positive activities
- 3. Improve their life and employability skills
- 4. Access the support they need
- 5. Provide up to date information, advice & guidance (IAG) to make INFORMED decisions.
- 6. Produce quarterly reports for funders and management
- 7. Manage and supervise other youth workers and Volunteers.



2. Key activities and responsibilities

- To lead regular evening sessions ensuring young people are able to engage with learning outcomes and contribute to session designs.
- Hold 1.1 case load and mentoring sessions with young people.
- Maintain accurate and up to date records of young people's development against learning outcomes.
- Undertake outreach to engage with disengaged young people who are at risk of entangled with gangs, crime, and anti-social behaviour
- Provide on-the-spot support directing to appropriate emergency and longer-term assistance and development.
- Delivering a Two times a-week youth project offering a range of activities and co designed provisions including games, positive activities and conversations, workshops, experiences and life and professional development experiences
- Supporting the delivery of creative and partnership projects
- Having conversations with young people, identifying issues affecting them and how their needs can be met
- Mentoring, coaching, and supporting individuals, encouraging young people to develop their self-awareness, independence, and individuality
- Identifying where targeted youth support is needed and facilitate referrals and connections
- Helping ensure that all evidence of projects are properly documented, and that work is evaluated and reported in accordance with contractual commitments
- Produce photography and video recording of activities for project promotion
- Producing monthly case studies of project participants
 Keeping registers, writing evaluation / sessional reports and inputting data into our management information system
- Lead on outreach activities, with other colleagues and in partnership with other services
- Obtaining necessary equipment as when required
- Recruiting and managing volunteers for the project
- Using social medial to engage young people in their communities
- Act as an ambassador for the organisation and help with publicising the project externally.
- Developing and building strong community relationships with external stakeholders i.e., schools and colleges, and developing relationships with youth networks in Tower Hamlets
- Staying informed on legislation, local and national issues, and best practice in youth work Ensuring child protection procedures are followed and that the safeguarding of young people is paramount
- Act as a role model for young people, inspiring them to engage in the services and understand and appreciate the role of youth work as a career opportunity
- Carry out all duties in accordance with HAAYA policies on Health and Safety, Child Protection and Data Protection, and with relevant legislation, Youth Worker Job Description and Personal Specification
- Any other duties appropriate to the post as directed by Line Manager.

4. Safeguarding / Policies & Procedures

- 1. To ensure all policies and procedures are adhered to.
- 2. Attend any designated safeguarding training as and when required.
- 3. Carry out all DBS checks for all staff and volunteers.

4. To ensure that Health and Safety processes are followed, and risk are minimised. This job description will be periodically reviewed with the post holder to take account of the changing demands and operational guidelines defined by HAAYA.
